Who can participate?

There are two studies. In the first study, you may be eligible to participate if you are a parent of a child (18 years or younger) diagnosed with:

* ADHD

In the second study, you may be eligible to participate if you are an adult (you do not need to be a parent of a child) diagnosed with:

* OCD or a psychotic disorder

What is involved?

The study will involve an interview about your views on either brain imaging or genetic testing in mental health, scheduled at your convenience, lasting for 30-45 minutes, at the University of British Columbia.

A \$50 gift certificate will be provided for participating, and \$10 to cover parking or transportation expenses.
